Note to the applicant:

- To be eligible to take the qualifying examination, the student must have completed at least 24 units of course work.
- The qualifying examination consists of a four-hour examination in economic theory (macroeconomics and microeconomics) and another two-hour examination in quantitative methods.
- To pass the qualifying exam:
 - a. must earn an average of 2.0 for the entire exam
 - b. must have no grade lower than 2.0 in both the microeconomics and macroeconomics theory exams
- Students who fail the examination may retake it only once.
