**Subject: Shifting/transferring into the BSE or BSBE programs in the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of AY 2020-21**


In view of the numerous adjustments to teaching and learning that we have had to consider this past semester, we will not be able to accept applications for shifting or transferring into the BSE or BSBE program for the second semester of AY 2020-2021.

We urge potential shiftees/transferees to instead use the upcoming semester to complete, and receive numerical grades for, Econ 11 and Math 21 or their equivalent, both of which are key requirements for shifting/transferring into our programs.

Those who are considering shifting/transferring as incoming juniors, should also complete, and receive numerical grades for, Math 30, BA 99.1 and 99.2, and Econ 101 and 102 or their equivalent.<sup>1</sup>

The equivalent of Econ 11 is the combination of Econ 100.2 and 100.2. For Math 21 (Elementary Analysis I) and 30 (Intermediate Analysis and Applications), please direct all inquiries to the UPD Institute of Mathematics.<sup>2</sup>

Whether you can take the above subjects may depend on your mother unit/adviser.
